



Golf Course User Guidelines – Rules of the Course

The ultimate aim is for all players to gain maximum enjoyment from the golf course at Chesterford Research Park. The overriding principal is that consideration be shown to others on the course at all times.

Safety Considerations

- The course should be played from **Hole 1 to Hole 7, in numeric order**. Please do not select OR stay on specific Tees/Greens as this causes additional wear and tear.
- Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or a practice swing.
- Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole when a player is about to play.
- **Players should Tee off from behind the Yellow Markers.**
- No player should play until the party in front is out of range.
- If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he/she should shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is “fore”.
- In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
- A player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by him/her is replaced at once and pressed down and that on the putting green any pitch mark made by them is repaired.
- Players should ensure that, when dropping the flagstick on the putting green, no damage is done to the putting surface and that no damage is caused to the hole when taking out or replacing the flagstick.
- Suitable “flat” footwear should be worn at all times on the greens and tees.
